Laguna National to Host Porsche Singapore Classic 2025 – Qualifier

27 November 2024, Singapore - Award-winning Laguna National Golf Resort Club will once again welcome top professional and amateur golfers as they compete for a coveted spot at one of the golfing world's most prestigious event.

Through this qualifier, three golfers will earn the opportunity to brush shoulders with some of the world's top players during the **third edition of the DP World Tour's Porsche Singapore Classic**, which will be held at Laguna National from 20-23 March 2025 as the opening event on the Tour's 'Asian Swing'.

The **Porsche Singapore Classic 2025 – Qualifier** will take place on Laguna National's acclaimed **Classic Course** on 18 February 2025, with nearly 100 participants vying for the honour. Among those hoping to emulate the uplifting feats of last year's Singaporean qualifiers trio - **Nicklaus Chiam, Joshua Yap and Irvyn Tan** – are local and regional talents eager to shine on the international stage.

While Chiam topped the standings with a 71, Yap edged out Thailand's Amarin Kraivixien in a play-off and Tan qualified as the low Singapore amateur.

Kevin Kwee, Executive Director at Laguna National, remarked:

“We are delighted to host this qualifier which not only guarantees representation from Singapore but also ensures a competitive field of the highest caliber. Supporting the development of golf talent in Singapore is a cause we are deeply committed to, and we’re thrilled to give local and regional golfers the chance to compete on a global stage”

The qualifier includes an official practice round on 17 February, followed by an 18-hole competition on 18 February, where the top two overall competitors and the top Singaporean amateur will gain entry to the US\$2.5 million Porsche Singapore Classic.

To encourage local participation, Laguna National is **subsidizing entry fees by 50% for Singaporean players** and offering access to practice facilities in the weeks leading up to the event.

Kwee added:

“Qualifiers offer a merit-based pathway to a golf championship, rewarding those who outperform their peers. Last year we were thrilled to see three Singaporeans qualify, and we hope to see this incredible achievement repeated in 2025.”

The Porsche Singapore Classic, launched in 2023, has become one of the region's premier sporting events. Inaugural winner Ockie Strydom of South Africa closed with a nine-under-par 63 to secure a thrilling one-stroke victory. The following year, Sweden's Jesper Svensson captured his first DP World Tour title after a dramatic playoff with Thailand's Kiradech Aphibarnrat.

With a rich history of hosting major events, including the Singapore Masters and the Aramco Team Series, Laguna National remains at the forefront of Singapore's golf scene.
