\*The completion of the Queen Sirikit Cup will take priority this week. While we are looking to open and maximise Member access, if there are any delays in the morning event times, afternoon Masters times may be delayed or cancelled.

Also, in preparation for this event, you will notice over the coming weeks some additional maintenance work being done on the Masters course.





1. Some areas that have many divots where balls collect in the fairways (ex. #1, #5 to the front right of the green, #18), will have nets placed over the area with GUR signs. Should your ball come to rest on these nets, you must take relief from this area as per the rules at the nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole.
2. To protect the competition pin positions and teeing ground, some flagsticks and tee markers will be placed in different locations than normal.

These measures will be temporary and in the interest of creating the best playing surfaces for this elite competition. We thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

For those that may wish to take in the action, limited spectators will be allowed on the course. Those that wish to come and watch will need to register as a spectator at the event registration desk and collect credentials to do so. This will be for competition days from May 24 – 27.

## Return of Pre-Covid golf course set-up

With the relaxing of Covid-19 safety measures, the Club continues to transition back to pre-covid set-up and practices. As such, you can expect to see 2 noticeable adjustments to take effect from Sunday, May 22, 2022:

- Return of bunker rakes
  - We must stress that with the return of the rakes, it is every Members' responsibility to rake the sand after hitting your shot. Take note of rake positions and grab one before you enter the bunker, so that you can rake all foot prints and divots on your way out of the bunker. Please note that, similar to fixing pitch marks, Members may be subjected to disciplinary action for failure to care for the course (including suspension).
- Removal of the foam inserts on flagsticks
  - With removal of the foam inserts, we revert back to the standard rules of golf, which do permit you to leave the flagstick in or remove it while putting. Please take care when removing and replacing the flagstick to not scrape or poke the edge of the hole.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind all golfers to also repair pitch marks on the green and fill/repair divots. Our golf course requires care from all of those that play it.
