



Dear Members,

The Multi-Ministry Task Force has recently announced the updates to the Phase 2 (Heightened Alert) measures as part of the nation's move towards becoming a COVID-19 resilient nation. As we continue to adjust our operations according to the guidelines provided, we ask for your kind cooperation in abiding by the rules and regulations in place and thank you for your kind patience and understanding. Kindly note the following, which will be in place from Tuesday, August 10, 2021, till further notice:

## GOLF COURSE REGULATIONS

### WEARING OF MASKS

By default, masks must be worn at all times with the exception of the following:

- While eating or drinking
- While engaged in strenuous activity
  - Masks can be taken off when performing strenuous exercise, although it is still recommended to not unmask as good practice even under such circumstances. Masks must be worn once the individual has ceased the strenuous activity (e.g. riding in buggies).
- For removal of all doubt, masks must be worn at all times and all places when not engaged in strenuous activity within the golf course

### LIGHTNING WARNING PROCEDURE

Please note that when a lightning warning comes into play, those who have already teed off and are in the golf course are permitted to remain on site and wait to resume their game. During a lightning warning, please proceed to one of the following areas:

- On-course halfway house
- On-course rain shelter
- The Nest
- Lightning Warning Overflow in the Car Park

When seeking shelter in the Halfway/Rain shelters, park your flight buggies together, wear your masks and remain a safe distancing of 3-meters from other groups at all times. If a shelter is full, please move to the next shelter or back to The Nest. If The Nest is full, please proceed to the Car Park area, keep your masks on at all times and maintain a 3-meter distance from other flights. Our team will update accordingly when it is safe to return to the course.

All tee times scheduled during the period of lightning warning will be cancelled.





We thank you for your cooperation in following these guidelines so that we can keep Laguna National a safe environment and allow for maximum golf enjoyment at the same time.

### **RAIN CHECK POLICY**

Based on our latest lightning alert policy where golfers playing at the course are able to wait and resume their games after lightning has cleared, the rain check policy for our guest golfers will be reverted to our previous arrangements (see below for terms and conditions) with effect from August 10, 2021.

- For the AM and PM 18-hole sessions, any guest golfers who are unable to complete their rounds due to various reasons, such as failure to cross-over, closure of the course due to darkness, etc., the rain check will be issued based on the following:
  - Guests whose tee time is cancelled as it is within the lightning alert time and prevented from teeing off – FULL REFUND IF PAID
  - Guests who are able to tee off and play up to one (1) hole – 18-HOLE RAIN CHECK
  - Guests who have teed off the 2nd hole and played up to ten (10) holes – 9-HOLE RAIN CHECK
  - Guests who have teed off the 11th hole – NO RAIN CHECK
  
- For the evening 9-hole session:
  - Guests whose tee time is cancelled as it is within the lightning alert time and they are prevented from teeing off – FULL REFUND IF PAID
  - Guests who are able to tee off and play up to one (1) hole – 9-HOLE RAIN CHECK
  - Guests who have teed off the 2nd hole – NO RAIN CHECK

\*\*Full buggy fees and applicable green fees, if any, must be paid when utilising any rain check.

\*\*No rain checks will be issued when a guest is utilising a green fee voucher.

### **WALKING GOLF RETURNS (MASTERS COURSE ONLY)**

With effect from August 10, 2021, golfers will have the option to walk at the Masters Course during the evening 9-hole session only. The walking fee\* of \$8.83nett will be charged to each golfer who chooses to walk. Limited golf trolleys will be available complimentary and will be on a first-come-first-served basis.

\*The walking fee is not refundable once the golfer has teed off.





## CHANGING ROOM FACILITIES

Changing rooms for both Golf and Social & Recreation will remain closed until further notice.

## FACILITY OPERATION HOURS

- GOLF BAG DROP: **06:30 – 21:00**
- THE SHOP: **06:30 – 21:00**
- GOLF CHANGING ROOMS (Toilets and basins only): **06:30 – 21:00**

## LAGUNA PRACTICE

The driving range remains a **MANDATORY MASK FACILITY**.

- All users must **WEAR A MASK AT ALL TIMES**, even when hitting balls at the bay
- Spectators are not allowed
- All users must have a booked slot

While using the short game area, you may remove your mask while engaging in a strenuous training activity, but please maintain a 3-meter safe distance from all other users. Kindly ensure that you put on your mask immediately when training is finished and at all times when you are moving around the facility.

## FOOD & BEVERAGE UPDATES

We are pleased to inform you that our Food & Beverage outlets will resume operations from August 10, 2021. You will be allowed to **dine-in in a group of up to five fully vaccinated\* persons**, according to the guidelines of the authorities. Unfortunately, unvaccinated persons will not be allowed to join in unless they have a valid negative pre-event test result or have recovered from COVID-19. For entry into the dining venues, kindly bring along your proof of vaccination, which can be retrieved from your TraceTogether app, HealthHub app, or from your hardcopy vaccination card.

*\*Please note: As stated in gov.sg, an individual is considered vaccinated if he/ she has been: a) fully vaccinated, i.e. has received the full regimen of Pfizer-BioNTech/Comirnaty, Moderna or the World Health Organisation’s Emergency Use Listing (WHO EUL) vaccines, with an additional two weeks for the vaccine to be fully effective, b) recovered from COVID-19, or c) has obtained a negative result on a pre-event test taken in the past 24 hours before the expected end of the event. Provision is made for unvaccinated children aged 12 years and below, who may be included within the group of 5 persons as long as all the children are from the same household.*

Please ensure that you wear a mask or depart the premise if you are not dining in at one of the outlets or using another facility at the club. To avoid congregation, gathering at the buggy area or outside any areas of the clubhouse is not allowed.

## SOCIAL AND RECREATION UPDATES

In compliance with the new regulations that will be effective from Tuesday, August 10, 2021, there have been updates on social and recreation activities allowed within our premises.



### Funshops by Stella

- Funshops organised will still be able to carry on.
- The maximum capacity for participants allowed will be at eight persons. As slots are subject to availability, please sign up earliest possible to avoid disappointments.
- For kids' classes, parents will not be allowed to stay inside the venue. Parents are highly encouraged to pick up their kids after the stipulated timing.
- Groups of two are allowed. A 3-meter safe distancing between groups is required and no intermingling is allowed.
- Masks can only be removed if you are consuming any food or beverage.
- If non-compliance with of any above, you will be asked to leave the class. No refund will be accorded.
- If participants do not feel well, please stay at home and the class fee will be refunded. Please seek medical attention immediately especially if you are having symptoms of flu, cough, sore throat or fever.

### Gym

- DFIT gym will be opened on August 10, 2021.
- The gym will be kept to a capacity of 30 persons at any one time.
- Only fully vaccinated members are allowed into the Gym. Kindly present your proof of vaccination (i.e. which can be retrieved from your TraceTogether app, HealthHub app, or from your hardcopy vaccination card) when signing in at our Laguna Lifestyle Counter.
- To avoid disappointment, members are highly encouraged to make reservation before visiting the gym.
- Members are reminded to wear mask if not doing strenuous exercises or hydrating.
- Members are highly encouraged to maintain a 3-meter safe distancing from each other.
- Members are highly encouraged not to speak loudly in the gym.
- Once you are done with the gym session, please leave immediately and do not inter-mingle with others.

### Outdoor Fitness Classes

- FloatFit and SwimSanity classes will resume from August 14, 2021, onwards.
- Members are reminded to wear mask if not doing strenuous exercises or hydrating.
- Members are highly encouraged to maintain a 3-meter safe distancing from each other.
- Once you are done with the classes, please leave immediately and do not inter-mingle with others.





### Swimming pool

- Group sizes of up to five persons are allowed.
- Members are only allowed to book one slot per visit per day. No multiple slot bookings allowed.
- Once the timing for the slot is up, please leave the swimming pool for other users of the next time slot to enjoy the facility.
- Stay in the same group throughout the visit to the resort.
- Stay at least 3-meters apart from other groups and do not intermingle.
- A mask must be worn at all times unless when you are in the swimming pool.
- Members are advised not to mingle in the resort as much as possible.

### Swimming lessons

- Private 1-to-1 swimming lessons are still ongoing.
- Group classes will resume from August 10, 2021, onwards.
- Up to five persons in a group, including the Swimming Coach, is allowed.

### Tennis Court

- Group sizes of up to five persons are allowed.
- Please stay in the same group throughout the visit to the resort.
- Please maintain maintain a 3-meter safe distancing from other groups and do not intermingle.
- A mask must be worn at all times unless playing tennis or drinking water for hydration.
- Members are advised not to mingle in the resort as much as possible.

### Tennis Lessons

- Private 1-to-1 tennis lessons are still ongoing.
- Group lessons will resume from August 10, 2021 onwards.
- Up to five persons in a group, including the Tennis Coach, is allowed.
