Your health and well-being remain our top priority as we continue to embrace the regulations put in place by the local authorities in the fight towards COVID-19. Following the recent update on the move to Phase 3 (Heightened Alert) measures, please note the following updates, which will be in place from June 14, 2021 until further notice.

REGULATIONS FOR GOLF ON-COURSE PLAY

Group Size

Four-balls are allowed to operate on the course as one group. However, distancing of 2m must still be kept between individuals and the 3m distancing must be kept between flights on the course. Golfers may only mingle within their own flight.

Wearing of Masks

By default, masks must be worn at all times with the exception of the following:

- While eating or drinking
- While engaging in strenuous activity
 - Masks can be taken off when performing strenuous exercise, although it is still recommended to not unmask as a good practice even under such circumstances. Masks must be worn once the individual has ceased the strenuous activity.
- For removal of all doubt, masks must be worn at all times and at all places when not engaging in strenuous activity within the golf course.
- Any golfers not abiding by the rules may be subject to disciplinary actions.

Gathering Before and After Game

Please note that gathering and consuming food and/or beverage before or after the game should be permitted from June 21 within one of our dining outlets. While dining outlets are still closed, you may consume food and drink during your game on the course.

To avoid congregation, gathering at the buggy area or outside any areas of the clubhouse will not be allowed.

We seek your cooperation in this matter – and with continued progress, we hope to further enhance your experience at Laguna National, while keeping everyone safe.





LIGHTNING WARNING PROCEDURES – ABANDON PLAY

June 14 to June 20, 2021

Please note that when a lightning warning comes into effect, play will be abandoned and we will need your cooperation to drive off the course proceed to the lightning evacuation parking at the ground floor of the car park – remove your clubs and proceed directly to your car or to the lobby to wait for your transport. Please help to maintain social distancing at all times and avoid congregating while you prepare to exit the property.

All tee times scheduled during the period of lightning warning will be cancelled.

LAGUNA PRACTICE UPDATES

Laguna Practice capacity will remain as current. You are encouraged to make bookings for a slot via phone at 6741 1111.

Wearing of Masks at Laguna Practice

By default, masks must be worn at all times with the exception of the following:

- While eating or drinking
- While engaging in strenuous activity
 - Masks can be taken off when performing strenuous exercise, although it is still recommended not unmask as a good practice even under such circumstances. Masks must be worn once the individual has ceased the strenuous activity.
- Masks must be worn at all times while moving around the facility.
- Please maintain distancing of 3m from others at all times.





SOCIAL AND RECREATION UPDATES

In compliance with the new regulations, there has been updates on social and recreation activities allowed within our premise.

Gym

- The use of indoor gym is allowed from June 21, 2021. Members are allowed to remove their masks when exercising.
- Members are welcome to make a booking for use of the gym from June 18, 2021.

Fitness Classes

- Fitness classes will resume from June 14, 2021, and is capped at a maximum of 5 participants.
- Multiple groups of 5 will be allowed from June 21, 2021. A safe distancing of 3 meters between groups will need to be observed and intermingling should be avoided.

Swimming pool

- Register in groups of 5.
- Stay in the same group throughout the visit to the resort and do not intermingle.
- A mask must be worn at all times unless when you are in the swimming pool.

Swimming lessons

- Group classes will resume from June 14, 2021.
- Private 1-to-1 swimming lessons are still ongoing.
- SwimSanity classes will resume from June 23, 2021 and multiple groups of 5 will be allowed.

Tennis Court

- A maximum of five guests are allowed for each game.
- Stay in the same group throughout the visit to the resort and do not intermingle.
- A mask must be worn at all times unless playing tennis.

Tennis Lessons

- Group lessons will resume from June 21, 2021.
- Private 1-to-1 tennis lessons are still ongoing.
