To provide a safe environment for you and all of our guests, we continue to monitor the situation closely and ensure the necessary precautions are in place. With the latest guidelines provided by the Multi-Ministry Taskforce, we would like to bring your attention to the following updates, which will be in place from Monday, June 21, 2021, until further notice.

GOLF COURSE REGULATIONS

Wearing of Masks

By default, masks must be worn at all times with the exception of the following:

- While eating or drinking
- While engaged in strenuous activity
 - Masks can be taken off when performing strenuous exercise, although it is still recommended to not unmask as good practice even under such circumstances. Masks must be worn once the individual has ceased the strenuous activity.
- For removal of all doubt, masks must be worn at all times and all places when not engaged in strenuous activity within the golf course.

Gathering Before and After Game

We are happy to inform you that all of our Food & Beverage outlets will resume operations from June 21, 2021 and you will be able to dine-in in a group of two. Members of the same household will be allowed to split across multiple tables, but they must follow the rule of two.

As restrictions on gathering and consuming food and/or beverage before and after the game remain, please ensure that you wear a mask or depart the premise if you are not dining in at one of the outlets or using another facility at the club. To avoid congregation, gathering at the buggy area or outside any areas of the clubhouse is not allowed.

Lightning Warning Procedure

From June 21, 2021

Please note that when a lightning warning comes into play, those who have already teed off and are in the golf course are permitted to remain on site and wait to resume their game. During a lightning warning, please proceed to one of the following areas:





- On-course halfway house
- On-course rain shelter
- The Nest
- Lightning Warning Overflow in the Car Park (ground floor)

When seeking shelter in the Halfway/Rain shelters, park your flight buggies together, wear your masks and remain 3m from other groups at all times. If a shelter is full, please move to the next shelter or back to The Nest. Please note that capacity at The Nest is reduced due to restricted dining. If The Nest is at full, please proceed to the Car Park (ground floor) area, keep your masks on at all times and maintain a 3m distance from other flights. Our team will update accordingly when it is safe to return to the course.

All tee times scheduled during the period of lightning warning will be cancelled.

We thank you for your cooperation in following these guidelines so that we can keep Laguna National a safe environment and allow for maximum golf enjoyment at the same time.

CHANGING ROOM FACILITIES

From June 21, 2021

Changing rooms will re-open. Lockers and showers may be used, but we still encourage all members to play, dine and leave the property so as to minimize exposure and interactions at the club. Those using the changing rooms are to maintain distancing and wear their masks at all times with the exception of when showering/washing the face – after which your mask must be promptly put on.

- GOLF CHANGING ROOMS: **06:30 – 21:00**





SOCIAL AND RECREATION UPDATES

In compliance with the new regulations, there has been updates on social and recreation activities allowed within our premise.

Gym

- The use of indoor gym is allowed from June 21, 2021. Members can remove their masks when engaging in strenuous exercise.
- Members are welcome to make a booking for use of the gym.
- Personal training will resume, and that our Personal trainers will go through a Fast and Easy Testing once every 14 days. This is our pledge of commitment to ensure your well-being and safety at all times.

Fitness Classes

- Fitness classes have resumed and multiple groups of two are allowed from June 21, 2021. Please observe a safe distancing of 3 meters between groups and refrain from intermingling.

Swimming Pool

- Register in groups of five.
- Stay in the same group throughout the visit to the resort and do not intermingle.
- A mask must be worn at all times unless when you are in the swimming pool and when you are not consuming any food or beverage.
- The relaxation pool will remain closed until further notice.

Swimming Lessons

- Group classes have resumed and Private 1-to-1 swimming lessons are ongoing.
- SwimSanity classes will resume from June 23, 2021 and multiple groups of five will be allowed.

Tennis Court

- A maximum of five guests are allowed for each game. Stay in the same group throughout the visit to the resort and do not intermingle.
- A mask must be worn at all times unless playing tennis.

Tennis Lessons

- Group lessons will resume from June 21, 2021.
- Private 1-to-1 tennis lessons are still ongoing.
