As the sun sets and lights dim, the bar takes center stage with bar flair performance by its award-winning in-house bartender. The Nest offers a wide selection of beers, cocktails and mocktails making it an ideal hangout for after work drinks and a chic venue for hosting an evening cocktail reception.

#### **Built for the world stage**

With the terrace just 12 meters away from the 18<sup>th</sup> hole green, The Nest was strategically designed and built to serve as a spectator interactive grandstand during golf tournaments and is located on the perfect spot to capture deciding moments on the last hole of the championship Masters Course.

Along with the nation's vision to become the best sports hub in the region, The Nest is an outstanding addition to the list of championship-worthy spectator stands amongst Singapore's golf clubs.

The Nest is currently Singapore's newest and most stylish 19<sup>th</sup> hole. It incorporates the concept of a sports bar with features such as textured wood finishings, a high stools bar, vintage wall posters with pictures of famous golfers and golf quotes, as well as usage of strong, dark tones across its interior furnishing.

### **About Laguna National Golf & Country Club**

A prominent golf club in the local and regional golf scene since its inauguration in 1993, Laguna National Golf and Country Club is one of Singapore's premier golf and country clubs offering two eighteen-hole championship courses – Masters and World Classic.

A multi-million dollar facelift is underway to develop a state-of-the-art union of a world-class golf club and a 206-room and villa branded hotel with full facilities including a spa, a driving range, a fitness centre, as well as Member-exclusive areas with private locker rooms, Members' lounges and country club facilities.

Over the years, Laguna National has won various local and international accolades. Its two eighteen-hole championship courses, namely World Classic and Masters courses, have hosted Tiger Woods, Ernie Els, Colin Montgomerie, Nick Dougherty and Vijay Singh. The Masters Course served as home for the European Tour's Singapore Masters from 2002 through 2007. The Club has since solidified its reputation further by receiving Tiger Woods on its World Classic Course for a private event during his maiden visit to Singapore in November 2011. In November 2012 Laguna National hosted the first ever overseas Korean LPGA Tour event and the inaugural Prudential Causeway Trophy in June 2013. The Prudential Causeway Trophy continues its second edition at Laguna National's World Classic Course in June 2014. In the same year, Laguna National hosted The Championship at Laguna National, an European Tour-Asian Tour co-sanctioned event,

### **About Masters Course**

The award-winning Masters Course is best known for gracing world class golfers such as Ernie Els, Colin Montgomerie, Nick Dougherty and Vijay Singh. From 2002 through 2007, the Masters Course served as host of the European Tour's Singapore Masters.

Ranked amongst the top courses in the world by Golf Digest International and Asian Golf Monthly, the Masters Course is characterized by a beautiful parkland landscape as it administers a stern test of golf. In 2014, the Masters Course was awarded the runner-up for Best Golf Course in Singapore and second runner-up for Best Championship Course in Asia Pacific at the Asian Golf Awards – Asian golf industry's longest running awards and accreditation programme. The Masters Course is over 7109 yards from the Championship Tees with a par of 72. The course rating is 74.0 and has a slope rating of 144.

### **About World Classic**

The totally redesigned (2011) World Classic course is a masterpiece by Andy Dye Designs that amalgamates "the best holes in one course". Featuring 18 holes of tremendously challenging golf, which have been inspired by the great courses of the world, it is now officially "Asia's Toughest Test" according to the globally recognized Slope/Course Rating System administered by the United States Golf Association to compare the relative course difficulties across all golf courses.

The World Classic Course is over 7350 yards from the Championship Tees with a par of 72. The course rating is 76.4 and has a slope rating of 162.

A finalist in Asian Golf Monthly's annual awards for Best New Design 2011, World Classic is the epitome of a private Members Club. It has been designed to provide both strategic and physical challenges to avid golfers.

The World Classic hosted Tiger Woods' first ever visit to Singapore as well as private play and exhibitions by both Tiger Woods and Ernie Els.
